

## **Edgar Law Firm Announces The Filing Of A Class Action Complaint Against Mass Mutual**

On October 19, 2011, Edgar Law Firm LLC and its co-counsel filed a Class Action Complaint ("Complaint") in the U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts on behalf of their client, Golden Star, Inc., and members of the proposed Class, against Mass Mutual Life Insurance Co. ("Mass Mutual"), alleging violations under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act ("ERISA"), 29 U.S.C. Sec. 1001, et seq. Specifically, the Complaint alleges that Mass Mutual receives revenue sharing payments from mutual funds in violation of various provisions of ERISA. The Complaint alleges that, while Mass Mutual classifies the revenue sharing payments as service fees, the fees bear no relationship to the cost or value of any services.

The Complaint seeks to represent a Class consisting of all administrators of employee pension benefit plans covered by ERISA and subject to Internal Revenue Code Sections 401 (a), (k) with which Mass Mutual has maintained a contractual relationship based on a group annuity contract or group funding agreement.
